### Kids Count in Michigan 2009 Report County Profiles of Child Well-Being

Childhood poverty, abuse and neglect continue to rise in Michigan but child deaths are down dramatically, the latest *Kids Count* report finds. The *Kids Count in Michigan Data Book 2009* examines county-level trends in child well-being with a focus on rural, mid-sized and urban counties. ### Kaiser Reports Record Medicaid Enrollment Illustrates Medicaid's Role During Economic Downturns

With the country mired in a deep recession, nearly 3.3 million more people were enrolled in state Medicaid programs in June 2009 compared to the previous June, according to a new analysis by the Kaiser Family Foundation's Commission on Medicaid and the Uninsured. It was the biggest ever one-year increase in terms of absolute numbers, and boosted the June monthly Medicaid enrollment by 7.5 percent to 46.9 million

It was the first time since the early 1990s that every state experienced an increase in Medicaid enrollment, and in 32 states enrollment grew at least twice as fast as the year before, according to the analysis, which includes data breakouts by state. Enhanced federal matching money for Medicaid provided through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 has proved critical in helping states maintain coverage. But that money is scheduled to expire on Dec. 31, 2010, which will increase the strain on state fiscal year 2011 budgets, Medicaid directors reported. [See Full Report.](#)

The report provides a long-term projection of the nation's dental workforce using statistical transition models for retirements, occupation changes, location choice, specialty education and death. It also includes national projections of the number of professionally active dentists, private practitioners, dental school applicants, first-year dental school enrollments and dental school graduates up to the 2030.
